## Reflections from Fr. Daryl

When Mary visited Elizabeth, she proclaims her great Magnificat give praise to God for all that he has done for her. Her soul rejoices in God for the gifts and blessing she has received from him. It is during this month of May that we especially look to Mary as our Mother. Jesus gave her to us on the cross when he said to the disciple, behold your mother. We have the May crowning's here at Saint Joseph by our school children, our Rosary group and others celebrating Mary as our Mother.

Today, as we celebrate Mother's Day, as a parish family, we look to our spiritual Mother and ask for her intercession as we so often do when we pray the Rosary and other Marian prayers. My favorite prayer devoted to Mary is the Memorare. The first part of the prayer states very clearly Mary's care and devotion to us, the disciples of her Son. "Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help, or sought thy intercession, was left unaided." We come to our Blessed Mother with the confidence that she will take our cares and concerns to her son Jesus.

As she raised Jesus as boy, her love for God and her son was always present. She cared for him, protected him, and taught him. What Jesus learned from Mary would prepare him in many ways for his ministry and ultimately his Passion. With the desire always to lead us into the loving embrace of Jesus, so that we might share in his eternal peace. On this day, Mother's Day, we are to be especially mindful of all that our mothers have done for us. We pray that our Lord will abundantly bless them as they have fulfilled the command to love in their motherhood.
