

Reflections from Fr. Daryl

After God gave the Ten Commandments to Moses, he gave a detailed description of how the Arc of the Covenant was to be built. This Arc, also known as the Tabernacle of God, would become the symbol of the presence of God in their midst. The Israelites would gather around the Arc for the religious celebrations throughout the year. When they reached the promised land, the Arc was placed in the meeting tent, where only the priests were allowed to enter. This would be the only temple building the Israelites would have for many years.

In a time of peace and favor for the Israelites, God gave the instructions for them to build the first temple. The first temple would take forty six years to build. The people would gather at all the proper times of the year for the major celebrations. Over the history of the temple, it would be damaged and ransacked several times. Each time, God would lead the people through the repair and rebuilding process until its final destruction in 70 AD.

Since many of the Israelites lived outside of Jerusalem, they would gather as the people of God in homes and city squares for the prayer and worship on the Sabbath as they were commanded by God. They understood that their relationship with God as his children was not dependent on a building or temple, but through the unity they shared through their belief in one God. This unity kept them strong though all times of difficulty and struggle, even when they would be placed in exile.

Our gathering last Sunday in the ballfield for the rosary and the cookout, was a wonderful reminder of our ties to the early Israelite communities. Our relationship with God our Father as his children and with Christ as our Lord is solidified when we come together as a parish family. Our church is our place to gather for prayer and worship. It truly is rock upon which our spiritual life is built and our unity is formed. But, as many have shared with me and with one another over this past week, we the parishioners are the reflection of God's love for us.

As we continue through this process, let us all keep in mind these words of our Lord:
If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask for whatever you want and it will be done for you. By this is my Father glorified, that you bear much fruit and become my disciples. As the Father loves me, so I also love you. Remain in my love. If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in his love. "I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and your joy may be complete." (John 15:7-11)


