Reflections from Fr. Daryl

I Created You (Anonymous)

One day, as usually was the case, a young waif, a little girl, stood at the street corner begging for food, money or whatever she could get. Now this girl was wearing very tattered clothes; she was dirty and quite disheveled.

As it happens, a well-to-do young man passed that corner without giving the girl a second look. But when he returned to his expensive home, his happy and comfortable family, and his well-laden dinner table, his thoughts returned to the young waif and he became very angry at God for allowing such conditions to exist.

He reproached God, saying, "How can you let this happen? Why don't you do something to help this girl?"

Then he heard God in the depths of his being respond by saying, "I did. I created you!"

As we go about our daily lives, we will come across such situations where we may indeed have the same thoughts as the young man in the story. We will question why this or that situation is present in our world. We may even question why God allows such conditions to exist. For each and every one of these conditions and situations, God has created someone to relieve them and bring about his goodness. They will only go unresolved if the person or persons he has created to overcome then fails to respond to the Lord's invitation to do something about them.

In today's second reading, St. Paul teaches us: *In him we were chosen, destined in accord for his purpose of the one who accomplishes all things according to the intention of his will, so that we might exist for the praise of his glory, we who first hoped in Christ.* (Ephesians 1:7) We are chosen by God to be his children. We seek to live for his purpose, not our own. God who has created us can only accomplish in us what he created us for when we are fully open to his will in our lives. We do not exist for our own glory, but for the glory of God in all things.

As we begin each day, we our intention is to be open to his will for us in all things. We may have our own plans and desires for what we want to accomplish for ourselves, but it is always to be within the context of what God has planned for us, so we may bring glory and honor to the one who has created us.

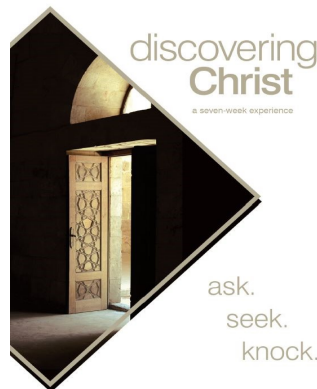
