Reflections from Father Daryl

Share These Gifts in Love of God and Neighbor

In this final reflection on the definition of Stewardship, we look at the last part of the definition: "we seek to share these gifts in love of God and neighbor." All that we have comes from God the Father who loves us beyond our comprehension. A love so deep that God gave us his only Son who suffered, died and rose so that we might have life in him. As faithful stewards, we are called to follow the example of Jesus in sharing our gifts.

Jesus at the last supper washes the feet of the disciples and tells them as he has done, so must they go and do likewise. These words are heeded by the faithful steward. The gifts we have freely received from God are to be freely shared with others. All the teaching, preaching and miracles Jesus gave during his ministry are clear examples of what it means to live not for ourselves but for God. He gave entirely of himself so that we might be one with him. We truly become one with our Lord when we live our lives in the love of God.

Although we have done nothing to deserve God's love, he generously bestows his love upon each of us. The love that is offered to us is offered so we might share in the joy that we are seeking in our life. As Jesus states so clearly, such love only becomes fully experienced when we follow him. All that Jesus did was out of love for us. It is not just a matter of saying a few words, but is reflected in our desire to bring this love to others through our deeds and actions. It is to be a way of life for the faithful steward.

The gift of love is first returned to God through our desire to follow not our own will but the will of Christ for us in our lives. When we become selfish, our attention is solely on our own wants and needs. When we become selfless, our focus is on the needs of others. We begin to recognize the gifts God has given us to build up his kingdom here on earth. When we share these gifts with God and neighbor, it is then that they are used for the glory of God.
