## Reflections from Father Daryl

As each day passes, we are able to see progress being made on the rebuilding of the Church. All can see the work that is being done on the roof on the outside, but few can see what is taking place on the inside. With the roof framing complete and the church dried in, there has been a lot of work being accomplished on the inside.

The large task of restoring all of the plaster is well under way. They continue to repair the damage to the ceiling as well as giving the entire ceiling a new layer of plaster that will repair all the cracks created by the water used to put out the fire. This will give us a new surface for the new paint throughout the church. All of the altars have been sent off to be repaired and restored. The statues are also currently being repaired and repainted. Soon the process of refinishing the pews will also begin. The entire electrical system is also being replaced, from the main power coming into the building to the outlets on the walls. We will also be adding additional lighting down the center of the church to go along with the two rows of lights we have. We are in the process of converting the two bathrooms into a single accessible bathroom, so we are re-plumbing the church so we will now have city water in place of the well water that we used before. We will be converting the west sacristy into an adoration chapel and enlarging the main entrance of the church. Once the scaffolding begins to come down, we will begin the process of adding new flooring throughout the church. The goal is to have the work completed by early March of next year.

While a great portion of the cost will be covered by insurance, there will be a cost to the parish for the upgrades and improvements we are bringing into the church. It is still the goal of the finance council and me to raise an additional \$300,000 to cover these costs. As of now, we have received \$23,878 toward this goal. I invite you to consider what you can contribute to this fund. As we progress through the project, we will need to cover these additional costs. I thank you for your consideration of a gift to this project.

When the church is completed, we will have a structure that was built in 1910 with a very up to date infrastructure and interior, which will serve the faithful of St. Joseph for years to come. May God bless us as we bring glory and honor to his name through this endeavor.
