Reflections from Father Daryl

Brothers and sisters: If there is any encouragement in Christ, any solace in love, any participation in the Spirit, any compassion and mercy, complete my joy by being of the same mind, with the same love, united in heart, thinking one thing. Do nothing out of selfishness or out of vainglory; rather, humbly regard others as more important than yourselves, each looking out not for his own interests, but also every-one for those of others. (Phil 2:1-4)

Over these past weeks, we have been invited to reflect on how we can become full alive as missionary Disciples of Christ. St. Paul in his words to the Philippians gives us a wonderful reflection to consider. When we consider our daily activities and obligations, where do we find ourselves fully alive? It is not so much in the daily tasks that we complete, but rather in our interactions with others. We find ourselves fully alive when we have the encouragement in Christ, when we participate in the Spirit, when we are able to share compassion and mercy and are united in the one love with one another. St. Paul invites us to make our joy complete through regarding others as more important than ourselves.

Each of you has received the stewardship renewal packet. In the packet there is the personal plan to be fully alive. This personal gives you the opportunity to make a commitment to yourself and your family to grow in the one mind and heart with our loving Savior.
