Reflections from Father Daryl

Christ the King

My kingdom does not belong to the world. If my kingdom did belong to this world, my attendants would be fighting to keep me from being handed over to the Jews. But as it is, my kingdom is not here.

As we celebrate the Solemnity of Christ the King, we are invited to reflect on the kingdom of God that Jesus refers to in the above passage. When we go back to the first calling of the Israelites in the Old Testament, God declares that they shall be a holy nation, a royal priesthood, a people set apart. The Israelites became the people of God who lived under the guidance of God the Father through the authority of the kings and prophets placed in their midst. When he sent his Son Jesus into the world, Jesus became the king who would reign over the people of God until his return.

By way of our baptism, we enter into the kingdom established through our Lord Jesus. We are now to live as the holy nation, a royal priesthood, a people set apart. While we may live our earthly lives under much authority, there is no greater authority to guide our lives than the one true king of our lives, Christ the king.

To be alive in his kingdom, we must strive to live holy lives. If we are to be a holy nation, we seek to know the commandments and to follow them in our lives. We will seek to understand our call to deny ourselves, take up our cross and follow our Lord. To share in the royal priesthood of Christ, we are to seek not to be served, but to serve our brothers and sisters in the same manner in which Christ came to serve us. We must be willing to sacrifice ourselves for the sake of one another and to seek each day to fulfill the will of Christ in our lives. To be the people set apart is to recognize that we belong to the kingdom of God, to live in this world, but not to be of this world. Our one true desire must be to live our life here on earth in such a manner that we will one day come to share in the eternal kingdom of Heaven.

As we celebrate Christ as our king, may we enter more deeply into our relationship with our Lord that we may recognize each moment that we are members of our Lord's kingdom here on earth and are seeking to reach His kingdom in heaven.

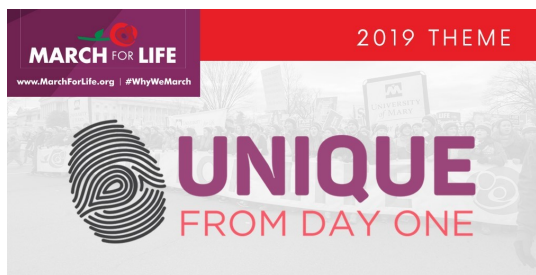
