Reflections from Father Daryl

The Rubrics

We are now in the Ordinary Time of the liturgical calendar. It is in this time that the Church directs us to focus on the hope that is found in Christ through the preaching of the Good News of the Gospel. In this hope, we are called to a continual growth in holiness and our desire to live as a faithful disciple to our calling. In his love for us, Christ fills us with the grace necessary to live holy lives. But, we need to do our part in striving for holiness.

The Roman Missal is the big red book the priest uses for all the prayers for the celebration of Mass and for other liturgies. The Church has set forth specific instructions on how the liturgies are to be celebrated. Contained throughout the Roman Missal are what are called the rubrics. These are instructions in red that direct the priest and the people on what they are to do in the celebration. For the liturgy, a rubric is defined as: a direction in a liturgical book as to how a church service should be conducted. Each priest is required to follow these rubrics contained throughout the Roman Missal.

Unless you actually look through the Roman Missal, you will most likely not see these rubrics. However, if you watch a priest through the celebration of mass, you will see him fulfill them. For instance, after the consecration of the Eucharist the rubric states: *He shows the consecrated host to the people, places it again on the paten and genuflects in adoration.* We see the priest do this at each mass, but are not able to read the specific rubric as it is in the Roman Missal.

In our life as disciples, Christ has given us specific instruction on how we are to conduct our life. In the scriptures, we find these instructions laid out before us. As we observe those who we would consider holy people, we can see them living their lives according to these instructions as well as what could be considered rubrics for how they conduct their lives. We can ask ourselves, what would be our rubrics for seeking faithfulness and holiness? In order to live the call of discipleship and holiness, this ordinary time of year can give us the opportunity to reflect on the expectations Jesus has for us to live lives worthy of the call of the Gospel.
