Reflections from Father Daryl

A week ago Friday, we experienced one of our Kansas Days. We had winter in the morning with the snow falling and giving us a light dusting. By noon, the sun was out and it felt like spring. In the middle of the afternoon, it felt like a cool summer day and as the sun began to set it was a nice fall day. It felt like we had all four seasons in one day.

As I walked around the parish in the afternoon I began to observe the melting snow. Everywhere the sun was shining, the snow quickly disappeared. In the areas where there was shade, the snow remained. Along the areas where the sun and shade met, one could see a clear line of the snow that had melted and the snow that remained. Even as you walked from the sunshine to the shade, you could easily feel the difference in the temperature. I tried to avoid the shady areas so as to feel the warmer temperatures from the sun.

Jesus has invited each of us to come and rest in the warmth of his love. In our day to day lives, the love of Christ is ever present to each of us, but we must seek to live in his love. In striving to live faithful lives of discipleship, we will at times fail to be faithful to his commandments and his will for us in our lives. It is when we have fallen into sin, that Jesus calls us back to himself. The longer we stay in the shade, the sins will remain. When we come into the warmth of God's mercy through the sacrament of confession, the sins we have committed will be wiped away.

The world can seem to us a dark and distorted world. For those who seek to live in the shadows this will remain true. But for those of us who live in the light of the Son of God, we will see his presence among us and will be led to lift up the world around us. It is only in the light of Christ that we will know the fullness of the love Christ has for each of us. In turn, we who are filled with his light must also be the ones who bring his light to those that we encounter each day.

Where do we seek to live our lives? Do we remain in the shadows and deny ourselves the warmth of God's goodness and love or do we seek to live in the fullness of his light? The choice will always be ours to make. In the light of Christ, we will share in the abundant life he came to give
