## Reflections from Father Daryl

### Dedication

We are now just four weeks away from the dedication and blessing of the Church with the Bishop. The mass will take place on Monday, March 18<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm, but our celebration will begin on Sunday afternoon. Here is what will take place on Sunday and Monday.

On Sunday afternoon, we will begin with a Sacred Music concert in the church. The Andale choir with additional musicians will perform the *Litanies of the Virgin* by Marc-Antoine Charpentier in 1684 directed by Bryan Lavery. Following the concert, there will be an open house in the church for all to come and spend time seeing all that has been done to the church.

At 5:30, we will have our annual social hour, followed by the parish dinner at 6:30pm. This year we will have the addition of the silent auction of items from the church that will no longer be used. This will include the pews that were not put back, lighting fixtures, stools, and chairs and other items that have been stored in the church unused for many years.

The Mass of dedication and blessing will take place on Monday evening. The Sacred Congregation for the Sacraments and Divine Worship states: "The rite for the dedication of a church and an altar is rightly considered among the most solemn liturgical services. A church is the place where the Christian community is gathered to hear the word of God, to offer intercession and praise to him, and above all to celebrate the holy mysteries, and it is the place where the holy sacrament of the Eucharist is kept. Thus it stands as a special kind of image of the Church itself, which is God's temple built from living stones. And the altar of a church, around which the holy people of God gather to take part in the Lord's sacrifice and to be refreshed at the heavenly meal, stands as a sign of Christ himself, who is the priest, the victim, and the altar of his own sacrifice."

In the weeks leading up to the celebration, I will share with you the main elements of the celebration to prepare us for the dedication. This will be a weekend filled with the grace of our Lord. I look forward to sharing in these events with all of you.
