## Reflections from Father Daryl

### Give Glory to God

## LENT BEGINS

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, March 6. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, April 19, are days of mandatory fasting and of abstinence.

Here are the regulations regarding fasting and abstinence.

### Fasting

Catholics, from their 18th birthday up to their 59th birthday (the beginning of the 60th year) are obliged to fast, that is, to take only one full meal and two lesser meals, with nothing eaten between meals. Drinking fluids is not contrary to the practice of fasting.

### Abstinence

All Fridays of Lent, including Good Friday and Ash Wednesday, are days of abstinence. All Catholics, beginning with their 14th birthday, are obliged to abstain from eating meat.

The church urges that works of penance be linked to works of charity. For example, using the money saved on less expensive meals or giving up snacks, to feed the poor.
