Reflections from Father Daryl

Temptation

A rich man was trying to hire a chauffeur and he interviewed three men for the position. He pointed to a high cliff near his house and said, "Suppose you were driving me on the edge of that cliff. How close could you safely come?" On man said, "I could easily drive the car within six inches of the cliff and not think anything about it." Another man said, "I certainly could come within a foot without you having to worry at all." Finally, the third may applying for the job spoke up, "I wouldn't go anywhere near the edge of the cliff; I would stay at least six feet from the edge!" As we begin this season of Lent, we have all made our commitments of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Through these commitments, it is our hope and desire that we will grow in our relationship with our Lord and our call to holiness. Prayer provides us with the opportunity to enter into a conversation with our Lord so that we may hear his will for us in our lives. Fasting leads us to make the necessary sacrifices to remove those things from our lives that keep us from living our faithful discipleship. Almsgiving leads us to be generous as our heavenly Father is generous is with us. Through these spiritual practices, we will grow in our holiness.

Even as we enter into these practices, we still live in the world that is full of temptations to turn away from our commitments and to easily give up on those commitments. The story above leads us to reflect on how close we allow ourselves to come to those temptations. Each time we pray the Lord's prayer, we ask Jesus to "lead us not into temptation." Yet, throughout our day, we will not do what is necessary to avoid those temptations.

A simple example. Say we have made the decision to give up deserts for lent. We go to a dinner that has a table full of deserts. If we walk up to the table and begin to look over all the deserts, we have placed ourselves into the temptation to pick one up. We could easily avoid the temptation by staying away from the table. This will hold true for us in our desire to avoid falling into sin. We must do our part with the grace from our Lord to avoid those things that lead us into temptation. The Lord is always at our side to keep a good distance between us and the temptation. May our Lenten season provide us with the discipline to avoid the temptations that can lead us to separate us from our Lord.
