Reflections from Father Daryl

Today, we begin the celebration of the Paschal Mystery of our Lord with the triumphant entrance of our Lord. Many people have come to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the long awaited savior of Israel. They are filled with joy as Jesus enters into Jerusalem and lay down branches and palms as he comes in singing: *Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest.* A few days later, this joy of the people and the praise they offer will change.

We begin the celebration of the Paschal Mystery listening to and meditating on the Passion of our Lord. We follow our Lord through his last supper with the Apostles, the agony in the garden to the mock trial and his crucifixion. Our loving savior suffers and dies so we might have abundant life. This is our solemn reminder that we are called to live the life our Lord has won for us through his death and resurrection. Our celebrations during these most holy of days will inspire us to share in the abundant life of our Lord. As we enter into the most holy of weeks, we would do well to follow the example of our Lord to prepare for these celebrations:

In the days when Christ Jesus was in the flesh, he offered prayers and supplications with loud cries and tears to the one who was able to save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverence. Son though he was, he learned obedience from what he suffered; and when he was made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him. (Heb 5:7-9)

On Holy Thursday, we enter the upper room with our Lord and the apostles to celebrate the Last Supper. Jesus knows all that is soon to take place. He will be betrayed by Judas, denied by Peter and abandoned by the other apostles. Knowing this, he gives to us the Sacraments of the Eucharist and the Priesthood. Jesus would welcome them back after the resurrection and send them to establish his church on earth.

On Good Friday, we witness the agony of the garden and the way of the cross of our Lord. It is the only day of the year on which no Mass is celebrated anywhere in the world. We venerate the cross on which the Lord gave his life so we might be freed from sin. He endures the death on the cross so we may have life.

On Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday, we share the joy of the resurrection. The statues are unveiled, the Gloria and Alleluia are sung and we renew our baptismal promises to reject Satan and profess our faith in the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. This joy can only be experienced if we have truly meditated on the passion of our Lord.

May each of us truly enter into this most holy week with the commitment to enter into our Lord's Passion and in turn rise with Him in the glory of the Resurrection.
