## Reflections from Father Daryl

### From the Ashes

As I reflect on where we have been over these last nine months as a parish community, the celebration of the Resurrection of our Lord takes on a new meaning. We often hear the phrase "we rise again from ashes" during the season of Lent, but how often do we take the time to reflect on the meaning of the phrase and how it pertains to our lives.

As we gathered around the church the day after the fire, we were able to begin to assess the damage. We could see that while the roof had the most damage, the interior of the church, while taking on significant water damage, still remained mostly intact. And most of the furnishings remained undamaged. When we look at our lives when we experience difficulties and struggles, much of the rest of our lives still remain untouched. We may be experiencing a time of sitting in the ashes, but when we unite ourselves to our Lord, we are being transformed by his love and strength.

Over the course of the nine months of the rebuilding, each day, week and month brought on a change in the church. First the roof was rebuilt, drying in the building. The ceiling was repaired and the walls resurfaced. The painting began and one could begin to see what the church would look like when completed. Along our journey of life, we are constantly renewed by the grace and love of our Lord. Jesus will continually reveal to us how he is transforming us into his image and likeness. The work the Lord does within us is slowly revealed to us, leading us to experience the joy he has in store for us.

As we celebrate today the resurrection of our Lord, we proclaim "let us rejoice and be glad". As I observed many people coming into the church to see it for the first time, this phrase could well be repeated by all. The beauty that fills the church now radiates the glory of God who guided us all along the journey. It is truly a place where we can experience the fullness of God's peace and joy. It is this rebirth in the resurrection of our Lord that Jesus invites us to experience in our lives.

On this Easter Sunday, we have an even greater reason to rejoice and be glad. God has brought us into a beautiful space to give glory, honor and praise. We celebrate our Lord's rising from the dead to bring us life and we rejoice knowing he has led us from the ashes of the fire to a church that radiates his glory. All is to be a reflection of what he does with each one of us. Leading us from the sorrow the world brings to the joy of his love for us and his desire to bring us everlasting life.
