Reflections from Father Daryl

Memorial Day

Originally called Decoration Day, Memorial Day is a day of remembrance for those who have died in service to our country. It was first widely observed on May 30, 1868, to commemorate the sacrifices of Civil War soldiers, by proclamation of General John A. Logan of the Grand Army of the Republic, an organization of former sailors and soldiers.

During the first national celebration, General James Garfield made a speech at Arlington National Cemetery, after which 5,000 participants helped to decorate the graves of the more than 20,000 Union and Confederate soldiers who were buried there. This event was inspired by local observances of the day that had taken place in several towns throughout America in the three years since the Civil War. By the late 1800s, many more cities and communities had begun to observe Memorial Day, and after World War I, it became an occasion for honoring those who had died in all America's wars.

In 1971, Congress declared Memorial Day a national holiday to be celebrated on the last Monday of May.

Memorial Day continues to be a day on which we remember all who have died in service to their country. This day has also become a day that we remember our loved ones who have gone before us. In the Rite of Christian Burial, we can find many comforting words. As we mourn the loss of a loved one and remember them on Memorial Day, we can especially take comfort in the following words.

We believe that all the ties of friendship and affection which knit us as one throughout our lives do not unravel with death. Our loving Savior assured us of this throughout his ministry. We are united with one another in the love that he has for us and the love we share with one another. In that same love, we continue to remember our loved ones with the sure and certain hope that one day we will be reunited with them in heaven.

We give you thanks for the blessing which you bestowed upon N. in this life: they are signs to us of your goodness and of our fellowship with the saints in Christ. As we remember our loved ones today, we will take time to remember the blessing they received in their life here on earth. We will spend time recalling the many good times shared with them. These are all reminders to us of God's goodness and his desire for us to share in his joy.

May each of us take time this memorial day to remember the sacrifices those who have served and continue to serve in the military make for us. Let us always keep in mind the love God bestows on us as well the unity we share with Christ and our loved ones who have gone before us.
