## Reflections from Father Daryl

### Ascension

Today we celebrate the Ascension of our Lord. In the Gospel from Luke, Jesus gives us a summary of what we have been celebrating throughout this Easter season.

*Jesus said to his disciples: "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. And behold I am sending the promise of my Father upon you; but stay in the city until you are clothed with power from on high.*

The fullness of God's love has been revealed to us shared with us throughout this holy season. We walked with our Lord through his suffering and death on the way of the cross. We rose with him on Easter Sunday filled with joy. We have been with the apostles as Jesus appeared to them teaching them to remain in his love. And today we watched with them as he returned to the Father. To use the words of Christ, *we are witnesses of these things.*

To be a witness to something can be understood in two ways. First, we are a part of the event ourselves. We are present to all that took place. The Apostles spent three years experiencing the teachings, the miracles and the Easter events with our Lord. While we have not listened to the Lord or walked beside him as the Apostles did, through this Easter season, we have become first hand witnesses to all that the Lord has done for us. Our celebrations have led us into the full experience of the Salvation won for us by Christ. Christ has led us into the very experience of his life, death and resurrection so we might know the fullness of his love.

Having now experienced all this through the Easter season, we must be ready to be a witness to the world. This is the second way in which one becomes a witness to an event. We must be ready and willing to proclaim this good news to the world. Our Lord has charged us to be his witnesses to the world bringing the love of God to all. We have received the same Holy Spirit as the apostles to fulfill our call as disciples. To bring the joy of the Easter celebration to all that we encounter. Each day, we must look within ourselves and ask if we have reflected this love in our words, our actions and most especially in our relationships. As Christ taught us, our faith is not to be kept hidden, but is to be proclaimed to all.
