Reflections from Father Daryl

With the Solemnity of Pentecost bringing the Easter season to a close, we now return to the ordinary time of the liturgical calendar. Through this ordinary time, we are called to reflect on the invitation of Christ to "follow me." These two simple words provide for us the opportunity to share in the fullness of life offered to us by our Lord. The next two Sunday's offer us celebrations to enter into this life.

First, we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity. In the mystery of the Trinity, we see the love of God shared between the three persons, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Before his Ascension, Jesus taught that he and the Father were one. In this unity, there is the love shared between the Father and the Son. Love is the binding force of the unity shared between the Father and the Son. Jesus would go on to pray as the Father has loved Him, so has He loved us. The love Jesus has for us is personified in the person of the Holy Spirit. The love shared between the Father and Son begets the Holy Spirit who is sent to us to teach us all things. Above all, the Holy Spirit opens our mind and heart to the love God has for us allowing us to live our lives in the love of God.

When we acknowledge that it is God who has first loved us through each person of the trinity, we come to experience in our lives the abundant life God has in store for those who love him in return. The abundant life flows not from the things of this world, but from the things of heaven. When we see all things around us as signs of God's love for us, it is then that we will also recognize that all is given to us from God to see his love.

At the last supper, Jesus gives to us the lasting sign of this love, the Most Holy Eucharist, which we celebrate on Corpus Christi Sunday. In the Eucharist, we have the gift of the new and everlasting covenant of love. This new covenant is the fullness of life and love that has been won for us through the suffering and death of Jesus. Jesus stated, "no greater love is there than this, to lay down one's life for one's friend." (John 15:13) The Eucharist becomes for us the source and summit of our lives. It is the source as it feeds and nourishes us with the love of God and it is the summit as it draws us to return our love to God.

It is the desire of Jesus that we might have life and have it more abundantly. We will experience this abundant life when we live our lives in God's everlasting love.

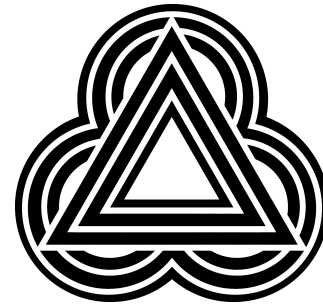
