Reflections from Father Daryl

We Are Only Passing Through

In the last century, a tourist from America paid a visit to a renowned Polish rabbi, Hofetz Chaim. He was astonished to see that the rabbi's house was only a simple room filled with books, plus a table and a bench. "Rabbi", asked the tourist, "where is your furniture?" "Where is your furniture?" replied the rabbi. "Mine?" asked the puzzled American. "But I am only a visitor here. I'm only passing through." Said the rabbi, "So am I."

While this is but a simple story, it clearly reminds us that our stay here on earth is not permanent. It is more like an extended stay hotel. Such a hotel allows us to use that which we do not own for a time, but once we check out, we take none of it with us. So it is with our journey of life here on earth.
