Reflections from Father Daryl

Brothers and sisters, You have forgotten the exhortation addressed to you as children:

"My son, do not disdain the discipline of the Lord or lose heart when reprov'd by him; for whom the Lord loves, he disciplines; he scourges every son he acknowledges."

Endure your trials as "discipline"; God treats you as sons. For what "son" is there whom his father does not discipline? At the time, all discipline seems a cause not for joy but for pain,

yet later it brings the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who are trained by it. (Hebrews 12:5-7)

When our family gathered for different events I would watch how my siblings would discipline my nieces and nephews when they would do something wrong and get in trouble. Each of my siblings had their own thoughts on how to discipline their children. However, I could always see a bit of how my mom and dad disciplined us in the approach of my siblings.

One particular cold winter day, several of my nephews had gone down to a small dry creek that happened to have water from recent rains and had a layer of ice on top. Three of my brothers each had a son playing down in the creek. The boys had taken off their jackets, (some fairly new) and were getting wet and dirty playing in the creek. When my brothers saw what they were doing what they had been told not to do, all three of them stood at the top of the hill and began yelling out the names of their boys, quickly reprimanding them and disciplining them.

As children, we do not like to be disciplined. Yet, it is an important part of our learning the difference between right and wrong. Consider the discipline you received from your parents growing up and the effect it had on you future decisions. Through discipline, we learn the consequences of making the wrong decision. A well learned lesson through discipline will lead us on the right path in the future.

In the letter to the Hebrews above, we can recognize that the Lord continues to discipline us in our lives of faith. God is always calling us to a deeper faith and a greater faithfulness to his commandments. Just as our parents disciplined us out of their love for us, so too does our Lord discipline us out of his love for us. Jesus knows what is going to lead us to sorrow and what will bring us joy. He will direct us toward the good if we allow him reprove us and fill us with his peace. Jesus's love for us is often realized through our suffering. When we are disobedient to God, we will bring upon ourselves suffering and sorrow. Through this suffering, we are reprov'd by God and will be led to a greater obedience to him in the decisions we make.

Jesus is always leading us to a greater understanding of his love. Are we open to the discipline we receive from him? When we are, we will understand more deeply his love for us and we will share in the peaceful fruit of righteousness.
