

Reflections from Fr. Daryl

Some of the programs I enjoy watching on television are on the Discovery Channel, History Channel and the DIY network. Several of the shows have to do with building, remodeling and renovations. I am often impressed with what people are able to do with both existing buildings as well as new construction. As one who enjoys such projects, watching these programs will also lead me to see what can be done here around the parish as well as for myself.

When I arrived here, I took the time to walk around the campus and explore the facilities of our parish. As I went through the basement of the parish hall, I was surprised to see that it was unfinished. While we do have several classrooms there, there is a large amount of unused space. So, I began to think about how this space could be utilized for the needs of the parishioners.

The first thing that came to mind is a space for our youth. Also, over the past couple of months, there have been requests by small groups to have a place to meet in the parish hall. To accommodate both the youth and the small groups, with the support of the parish council and the finance council, the decision has been made to finish the basement with a youth room and three additional meeting rooms.

The work on this project will begin Monday, June 12th and continue through its completion. I am asking for volunteers to assist with this project. Work will generally begin around 10:00 am and continue through the day, concluding around 9:00pm. Each Sunday, I will announce what work will be taking place that week as the project progresses.

The first week will be getting the wall built. Tools needed for this work will mainly be screw guns. Those who wish to volunteer are asked to bring their own if they have them. I look forward to completing this project this summer, which will allow the CYM to have their own space and will provide spaces for both classrooms and meeting rooms.


