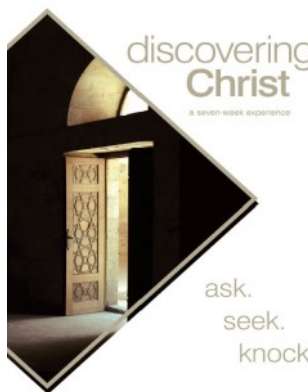

## STEWARDSHIP

"...my word shall not return to me void, but shall do my will, achieving the end for which I sent it." The prophet Isaiah compares the word of the Lord to the snow and rain that waters the earth and makes it fertile. It was sent for a purpose and it does not return to the Lord without fulfilling that purpose. Jesus shares the Parable of the Seeds, and proclaims a similar message. The seed was designed for growth and fruitfulness. Both of these readings speak to a life of stewardship -- a life in which a person recognizes that he or she was created for a purpose and spends his or her life fulfilling that purpose! Woe to those who "have eyes but do not see." While those people may recognize their purpose, they choose a different path, one filled with thorns or rocky soil. They do not bear fruit and are miserable for it. The good steward is fruitful; he seeks the will of God and achieves the end for which he was sent.
