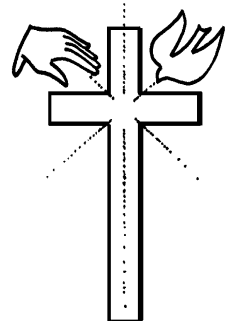

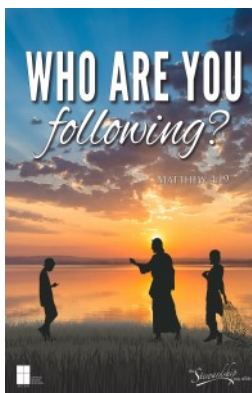
OUT OF DISTRICT RELIGION
