## Reflections from Fr. Daryl

### It is Right to Give You Thanks and Praise

In every celebration of mass, we proclaim this response during the preface for the Eucharistic Prayer. The celebrant invites the people through the words, "Let us give thanks to the Lord our God" and the assembly responds, "It is right to give him thanks and praise." Take some time to reflect on these words.

*"It is right"* When we receive a gift, we show our gratitude by saying thank you. We say the words, we send cards or we do something extra to show our appreciation and gratitude. God has provided us with all that we need, so it is right, proper, appropriate and necessary, to give him thanks.

*"To Give You"* We give thanks to God because he is the source of all good things. All that we have is given to us as a gift. Our lives should reflect our gratitude to God in all that we do and say. Are we taking time each day to give to God the thanks he deserves?

*"Thanks and Praise"* This is a response to that which fills us with joy. God does so many good things for us, that we should be filled with a desire to give him thanks and praise. But, we must first recognize the gifts he has given us. Once we do, we will be filled with the need to offer him thanks and praise.

So how does all of this happen in our daily life? It is called Stewardship. Stewardship is a way of life through which we show our gratitude through a return of our time, talent and treasure. When stewardship becomes a part of our Life in Christ, we will be filled with thanks and praise for all that we do, not just in our life here on earth, but our life beyond as well.

*"Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and decay destroy, and thieves break in and steal. But store up treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor decay destroys, nor thieves break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be. {Mat 6:19-21}"*

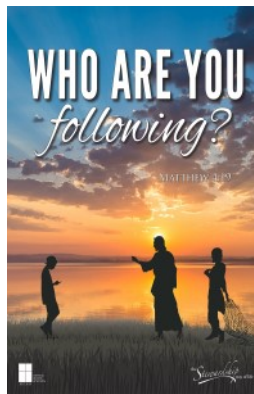

we are murderous, but that we tend to want more than we have been given? This is a dangerous mindset for the steward, as it is not an "attitude of gratitude." Rather, as followers of Jesus Christ, we should stop to notice the wonderful vineyard God has created for us, and be grateful for the opportunity to care for it. Otherwise, it may be "taken away and given to a people that will produce its fruit."
