## Reflections from Fr. Daryl

"Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God" (Mt 22:21). These words of our Lord to the Pharisees open to us a deeper understanding that while we are of the world, we belong to the kingdom of God. In calling us to live our lives as disciples, it is to be our desire in all things to build up the kingdom of God in all that we do.

Our daily lives are filled with responsibilities and obligations. Each day, we get up recognizing that there are things that we must do for the sake of this world. Whether it be through our jobs, our schools or our businesses, we have to complete the work necessary to keep the world in which we live what we want it to be. We recognize that when we do not fulfill our responsibilities, then there will be outcomes that are not favorable for us or for those around us.

Jesus teaches us that we must have the same attitude and desire for building up the kingdom of God. The Stewardship way of life is the avenue through which we can give to God what belongs to God. God has provided all that is necessary for us to build up his kingdom here on earth. He provides each of us the gifts and talents necessary to make his love known through our lives. We are invited to reflect each day on how Jesus is asking us to use these gifts and talents to build up his kingdom. St. Francis stated simply: "Preach the Gospel at all times, when necessary, use words". These words can be fulfilled through each of us when we seek to use the gifts we have received in our daily lives.

Too often, we see our treasure only in the return of our tithe. Yes, it is through an intentional, proportionate and sacrificial gift that we give to God what belongs to God. But, Jesus charges us to build up for ourselves treasure in heaven. The greatest return to God Jesus gave was the gift of his life. Have we committed the treasure of our life to be placed at the service of our Savior? This treasure is returned to our Lord through gift of our time given in service of one another.

Over these coming weeks, we will be challenged to ask the question: Who are you following? This is the theme for our annual Diocesan commitment to living more fully the Stewardship way of life.

## STEWARDSHIP

Isaiah 45:6 "I am the LORD, there is no other." In today's Gospel, the Pharisees try to trap Jesus by asking if it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar. They are hoping to snare Him using false flattery and either the Jewish law or the political law of the day. Of course, Jesus doesn't fall into the trap. His response: "Then repay to Caesar what is Caesar's, and to God what is God's." The steward realizes that everything belongs to God, the creator of all things. Jesus knows this, too. However, He also knows that God has little use for tax dollars...what HE wants from us -- our whole-hearted love -- is much more valuable. His response is aimed at the commandment against idolatry, and is a call to follow God. In fact, His response sounds very much like our Stewardship Theme, "Who are you following?"
